SEWING - DOMESTIC

Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first served). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. No instructions are offered - you must have sewing experience but, volunteers are available to help. This is only available for Class Fee - FREE domestic machines.

Sewing Machine Operator Domestic Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools. Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private. Robert Lackie - Instructor 1 session 2.5 hours Fee \$30 Basic Sewing —Part 1 Learn to operate a domestic machine. Learn to use the tools of the sewing trade for proper measuring, marking and cutting. Learn to sew on buttons and simple hand stitching. Use these skills to make several simple projects. Earn a certification thru testing, if wanted. All materials provided. 9 sessions of 2.5 hrs. Fee \$270

Basic Sewing - Part 2 Building on the skills learned in Part 1 or start where you are. You will learn seams and seam finishes and then apply this to simple projects. Learn hem types while making an apron and finally buttonholes and hook and snap closures. Earn a certification thru testing, if wanted. 9 sessions of 2.5 hrs. Fee \$270 All materials provided. Garment Construction This course is the next step after Intro to Garment. In Garment Construction Elements you will be introduced to elements of garments such as collars & cuffs, pockets, waistbands. Learn the sewing vocabulary terms and make samples of these fundamental elements for future reference. Make a pant/skirt and sample top. 12 weeks of 2.5-hour sessions, Fee \$360

Serger Workshop This class covers basic serger sewing. Proper Threading and maintenance, thread tension and understanding serger features. Participants of this class will create a workbook with samples of stitches, mastering curves on your serger, creating special hems and more. Bring your own serger or reserve one of ours.
