### **November 2020 Activities & Classes**



ATTENTION – Due to COVID Restrictions – all classes will have limited enrollment!! It is best to pre-register. If you arrive without pre-registering and the class is full you will be turned away. This includes Open Sew & Rental.

Limited sponsorships are available to cover some fees – Ask for application \*\*

Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. No instructions are offered – you must have sewing experience but, volunteers are available to help. This is only available for domestic machines. Limited to 5 persons.

Class Fee is FREE

Simple Sewing Project – Each month we offer a simple sewing project that is quick and suited for beginner sewists or kids with help.

November = cloth napkins, just in time for holidays. Choose from our stash of fabrics or bring your own. (1/2 yd. = 3 napkins) Fee \$15

<u>Literacy KC/Don Bosco- Sewing as a Second Language</u> - Training - closed classes - enrollment available thru Literacy KC

Shibori Dye Workshop - In this class you will learn the Japanese art of Arashi (pole wrapping). It is one of many techniques under the umbrella of Shibori, which means shape resistant dyeing. Shibori is a Japanese term for several methods of dyeing cloth with a pattern by binding, stitching, folding, twisting, or compression. All materials and dyes are included.

1 session 3 hrs. \$65

#### Sewing

Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome. Must have sewing machine operator skills for this class. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 6-8 pm.

Sessions run 6 weeks Fee \$ 120

Sewing Machine Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools.

Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private. 1 session 2.5 hours Fee \$25

Pencil Skirt — In this class you will draft your custom fit pencil skirt and then make one to fit. Skirt elements include self-lining and zipper closure. Materials for class are chosen from our stash or bring your own. Supply list given at registration.

3 session 3hr. ea. Fee \$90

#### **Job Skills Training**

Industrial Basics – M/TH – class held 2 times per week & is part of our "Salon" program which includes up to 40 weeks – covering Industrial, Domestic, & Entrepreneurial courses. This course is for the person interested in securing employment or entrepreneurship in sewing. Learn the skills to operate several types of industrial machines: straight needle, serger, cover-stitch and more. Skill building for accuracy & speed using real work samples, real work-room site tours included. Course consists of class lectures, lab work and homework. Includes Tool Kit & materials.

Industrial Sewing Machine Rental – Do you need an Industrial machine to get your sewing business started but can't yet make this investment? You can rent an Industrial Straight needle or serger machine @ The Sewing Labs to get your sewing business started.

Industrial machines are meant for production or entrepreneurial sewing. \*\* Pre-requisite of Industrial Operator Classes is required – offered monthly \*\*\*

Rental is in 4-hour increments for \$20. Contact TSL to register

Industrial Machine Operator & Safety – New to The Sewing Labs – if you are wanting to rent an Industrial sewing machine @ TSL you will be required to take this 1 session course to review the basic operation & safety of straight & serger industrial machines. This course is held monthly, and it must be completed BEFORE machine rental is allowed.

1 session – 2.5hrs. Fee \$50

Basic Sewing – Phase 1 – Certification – Learn to master a home machine operation, learn to use the tools of the sewing trade, then add the building blocks of sewing, seams, finishes, zippers, closures, buttons and more. Earn a certification thru testing. Then use these skills to start your own business or acquire a job in sewing. All materials provided.

10 sessions of 2 hrs. Fee \$200
