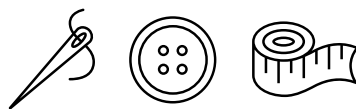

Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. No instructions are offered – you must have sewing experience but, volunteers are available to help. This is only available for domestic machines. Limited to 5 persons. **Class Fee is FREE**

Simple Sewing Project – Each month we offer a simple sewing project that is quick and suited for beginner sewists or kids with help. **December = Monogrammed Stockings**, just in time for holidays. Choose from our home décor remnants to make one (1) **Fee \$20**

Literacy KC/Don Bosco– Sewing as a Second Language – Training - closed classes – enrollment available thru Literacy KC

Shibori Socks & PJs (Dye Workshop) - In this class you use the Japanese art of Arashi & Indigo dyeing while creating unique designs on premade PJ pants and socks. A great gift for yourself or someone on your list. Ann Greenleaf will guide you thru this fun workshop. You must bring your own 100% cotton premade PJ pants and a 6 pack of socks **1 session 3 hrs. \$55**

Sewing

Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome. Must have sewing machine operator skills for this class. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 6-8 pm. **Sessions run 6 weeks Fee \$ 120**

Sewing Machine Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools. Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private. **1 session 2.5 hours Fee \$25**

Table runner with Holiday embroidery Make a decorative table runner accented with holiday embroidery just in time for your holiday table. All materials included - choose from our home décor remnants. **1 session 3hr. Fee \$30**

Zippered Make Up Bag – Make this fun personal sized make up bag with zipper – a perfect gift. All Materials included **1 session 3 hr. Fee \$30**

Job Skills Training

Industrial Basics –New session in January - get on the list NOW! - TSL “Salon” program includes up to 40 weeks – covering Industrial, Domestic, & Entrepreneurial courses. This course is for the person interested in securing employment or entrepreneurship in sewing. Learn the skills to operate several types of industrial machines: straight needle, serger, cover-stitch and more. Skill building for accuracy & speed using real product samples, local work-room site tours included. Course consists of class lectures, lab work and homework. Includes Tool Kit & materials. **Fee \$532/monthly or \$5000**

Industrial Sewing Machine Rental – Do you need an Industrial machine to take your sewing business to the next level but can't yet make this investment? You can rent an Industrial Straight needle or serger machine @ The Sewing Labs. Industrial machines are meant for production or entrepreneurial sewing. **** Pre-requisite of Industrial Operator Classes is required – offered monthly *****

Rental is in 4-hour increments for \$20. Register on line @ [TSL Machine Rentals](#)

Industrial Machine Operator & Safety – New to The Sewing Labs – if you are wanting to rent an Industrial sewing machine @ TSL you will be required to take this 1 session course to review the basic operation & safety of straight & serger industrial machines. This course is held monthly, and it must be completed BEFORE machine rental is allowed. **1 session – 2.5hrs. Fee \$50**

Basic Sewing – Phase 1 – Certification – **New Session in January = get on the waiting list NOW!** Learn to master a home machine operation, learn to use the tools of the sewing trade, then add the building blocks of sewing, seams, finishes, zippers, closures, buttons and more. Earn a certification thru testing. All materials provided. **10 sessions of 2 hrs. Fee \$200**
