Simple Sewing Project – Each month we offer a simple sewing project that is quick & suited for beginner sewists or kids with help Silk Scarf Shibori Workshop – Shibori is a Japanese term for several methods of dyeing cloth with a pattern by binding, stitching, folding, twisting, or compressing it. Ann Greenleaf, your instructor, will teach you to dye a premade silk scarf using Shibori methods. All materials and dyes are included. **1 Session 3 Hrs. \$65**

Industrial Production– Sewing Salon - This course covers introduction to industrial straight needle & serger. Production skill building for<br/>accuracy & speed using real work samples, real work-room site tours included – when possible. Course includes lectures, lab, and homework.<br/>Includes Tool Kit & materials. Instructor – Cali Roberta10 weeks with 2 – 3-hour sessions per week, Fee \$800 or 2 payments of \$410Beginning Industrial & Production – Learn to operate a straight needle & serger industrial machine including operation, threading, tension,<br/>and trouble shooting. Industrial machine will allow you to sew faster & take your business to the next level.10 sessions, 2hr. Fee \$200Machine Rental – Industrial- Do you need an Industrial machine to get your sewing business started but can't yet make this investment? You<br/>can rent an Industrial Straight needle or serger machine @ The Sewing Labs and take your business to the next level.Rental is in 4-hour increments for \$20

Industrial Machine Operator & Safety – New to The Sewing Labs – if you are wanting to rent an Industrial sewing machine @ TSL you will be required to take this 1 session course to review the basic operation & safety of straight & serger industrial machines. This course is held monthly, and it must be completed BEFORE machine rental is allowed. **1 session – 2.5hrs. Fee \$50** 

Basic Sewing – Phase 1Learn to master a home machine operation, learn to use the tools of the sewing trade, then add the building blocks<br/>of sewing, seams, finishes, zippers, closures, buttons and more. Earn a certification thru testing. Then use these skills to start your own<br/>business or acquire a job in sewing. All materials provided.Description<br/>10 sessions of 2 hrs. Fee \$200

Phase 2 Garment Basics - Phase 2 /Part 1 Certification – Learn the fundamental of garment construction – from Intro to Patterns & fitting, Textiles – grainlines and fibers, understanding; linings, darts, gathers, under stitching, grading and more. You will construct a simple top practicing these skills. Must have sewing machine operator skills for this class. Business of Sewing – Entrepreneurial – February – "Planning for a Healthy Business" Each month learn different aspects of running a sewing

business of ocwing "Entrepreneurial Teordary" Framing for a freative professionals their stories of startup & running of their businesses. FDIC notebook provided. Zoom format - 2nd & 4th Tuesday, 6-7:30 pm. Fee \$30 mon. or \$200/yr. (13mths.)

Serger Workshop- Serger Basics - Learn how to use a serger. Bring your own serger to add to your skills or use ours. This class covers basic<br/>serger sewing. Proper Threading and maintenance, thread tension and understanding serger features. Participants of this class will create a<br/>workbook with samples of stitches, mastering curves on your serger, creating special hems and more.2 sessions of 3 hr. Fee \$ 60Community

Volunteer Orientation – currently via ZOOM. Do you want to volunteer @ TSL? Do you just want to know more about it? TSL requires all its volunteers to attend an orientation. This is a great opportunity to explore what is happening @ The Sewing Labs. Pre-registration is recommended.
