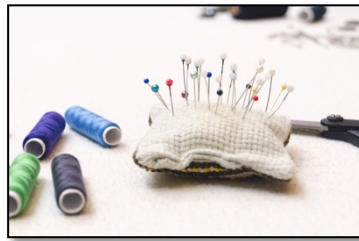
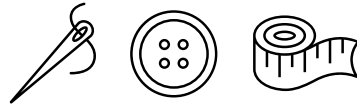

January 2021 Activities & Classes

Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. No instructions are offered – you must have sewing experience but, volunteers are available to help. This is only available for domestic machines. Limited to 5 persons. **Class Fee is FREE**

Simple Sewing Project – Each month we offer a simple sewing project that is quick and suited for beginner sewists or kids with help.

January – Fleece Hat & Scarfs – make one for yourself or donate back to the **Fee \$15**

Literacy KC/Don Bosco– Sewing as a Second Language – Training - closed classes – enrollment available thru Literacy KC

Sewing

Knitwear & Indie Patterns with Pam – Introducing Pam Davidson of Josephine Sews Blog – Learn how to use “indie” patterns while learning to sew with knits. Fit & construct leggings in Jan. and a tunic top in Feb. Kit available for materials for additional fee or bring your own fabrics – more info at registration. **Course options – Leggings (5 sessions) \$100 or Tunic (5 sessions) \$100 or both Fee \$200**

Coming in February - Elements of Garments – Phase 2 / Part 1 Certification – Learn the fundamental of garment construction – from Intro to Patterns & fitting, Textiles – grainlines and fibers, understanding; linings, darts, gathers, under stitching, grading and more. You will construct a simple top practicing these skills. Must have sewing machine operator skills for this class. **Sessions run 10 weeks Fee \$ 200**

Sewing Machine Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools. Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private. **1 session 2.5 hours Fee \$25**

Zippers – Learn how to install – Centered, Invisible, lapped and separating zippers. You will make samples for future reference. Each week will be a different zipper - take 1 or all 4 **1 session Fee \$20 or all 4 sessions Fee \$80**

Job Skills Training

Industrial Production Basics - class held 2 times per week & is part of our “Salon” program or can be taken separately. This course covers introduction to industrial straight needle & serger. Production skill building for accuracy & speed using real work samples, real work-room site tours included – when possible. Course consists of class lectures, lab work and homework. Includes Tool Kit & materials. **10 weeks with 2 – 3-hour sessions per week, Fee \$800 or 2 payments of \$410**

Beginning Industrial & Production Sewing – Are you wanting to learn how to use an Industrial machine to take your sewing to the next level? Learn to operate industrial straight needle and sergers while learning tips and tricks to production sewing with our Industrial Instructor and Production Manager – Cali Roberta **10 session of 2 hrs. Fee \$200**

Machine Rental – Industrial – Do you need an Industrial machine to get your sewing business started but can’t yet make this investment? You can rent an Industrial Straight needle or serger machine @ The Sewing Labs and take your business to the next level. **Rental is in 4-hour increments for \$20**
** Pre-requisite of Industrial Operator Classes is required – offered monthly

Industrial Machine Operator & Safety – New to The Sewing Labs – if you are wanting to rent an Industrial sewing machine @ TSL you will be required to take this 1 session course to review the basic operation & safety of straight & serger industrial machines. This course is held monthly, and it must be completed BEFORE machine rental is allowed. **1 session – 2.5hrs. Fee \$50**

Basic Sewing – Phase 1 – Certification – Learn to master a home machine operation, learn to use the tools of the sewing trade, then add the building blocks of sewing, seams, finishes, zippers, closures, buttons and more. Earn a certification thru testing. Then use these skills to start your own business or acquire a job in sewing. All materials provided. **10 sessions of 2 hrs. Fee \$200**

Business of Sewing – Entrepreneurial Courses – January - “Owning a business – is it a good fit?” Each month learn different aspects of running a sewing business taught by local business professionals & learn from local creative professionals their stories of startup & running of their businesses. FDIC notebook provided. Zoom format - 2nd & 4th Tuesday, 6-7:30 pm. **Fee \$30/mth**
