Quilting with Half Square Triangle — This class will explore the many ways you can use half square triangles in quilts. Participants should be able use a sewing machine, rotary cutter and consistent 1/4-inch seam. The project will be a lap size quilt top sized at 64 X 64 inches. or 56 X 72 inches completely of half square triangles. Fabric will be available at The Sewing Labs for the project 3 session 2.0 hrs. Fee \$ 96

Sewing - Domestic

Open Sew—Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. No instructions are offered — you must have sewing experience but, volunteers are available to help. This is only available for domestic machines.

Class Fee — FREE

Hemming Pants – Do you have pants or jeans that need hemmed? Learn the bases of hemming pants using a sewing machine.

Bring 1 pair of pants to hem in class.

1 session 2.5 hours FEE \$25

Sewing Machine Operator Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools.

Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private. Robert Lackie - Instructor

1 session 2.5 hours Fee \$25

Basic Sewing —Part 1 Learn to operate a domestic machine. Learn to use the tools of the sewing trade for proper measuring, marking and cutting. Learn to sew on buttons and simple hand stitching. Use these skills to make several simple projects. Earn a certification thru testing, if wanted. All materials provided.

9 sessions of 2'5 hrs. Fee \$200

Basic Sewing – Part 2 Building on the skills learned in Part 1 or start where you are. You will learn seams and seam finishes and then apply this to simple projects. Learn hem types while making an apron and finally learn to apply buttonholes, hook and snap closures. Earn a certification thru testing, if wanted. All materials provided. (Sewing machine operation required)

9 sessions of 2.5 hrs. Fee \$200

Intro to Garments - This course takes you from Basic Sewing into Garment Elements and Construction. You will be introduced to patterns, fabric & fiber types. You will learn to decipher sewing vocabulary gaining understanding and making samples of facings & linings, curved seams and corners, darts, tucks and gathers. You will learn the proper way to cut out a garment while making a simple top. This course involves a lot of sewing and sewing homework to assure your success.

10 weeks of 2.5-hour sessions Fee \$250

Zippers – Does applying zippers scare you? Each week Cali Roberta will guide you through mastering zipper installation. You can learn 3 different zippers if you want to be attending each week's class or you can just take the one session you need. Weekly \$25 each week or 3 sessions for \$60.00

Industrial

Industrial Machine Operator & Safety – New to The Sewing Labs – if you are wanting to rent an Industrial sewing machine @ TSL you will be required to take this 1 session course to review the basic operation & safety of straight & serger industrial machines. This course is held monthly, and it must be completed BEFORE machine rental is allowed. - next session will be in November 1 session – 2.5hrs. Fee \$50

Machine Rentals (Industrial) - Do you need an Industrial machine to get your sewing business started but can't yet make this investment? You can rent an Industrial Straight needle or serger machine @ The Sewing Labs and take your business to the next level. Longarm quilting coming soon!

Rental is in 4-hour increments for \$20 & up

Longarm Quilting Rentals – Available only on Wednesday currently from 10-4

Job Skills Training

Salon Sewist Training Program (SSTP)- Prepare yourself for employment or entrepreneurship in the profession of sewing. SSTP is a vocational training program with a commitment of up to 30 weeks of hands-on sewing instruction on both domestic and industrial machines and entrepreneurial business training to support you. – Now taking applications for Spring Session

Sewing Salon Entrepreneurial / Business of Sewing—Each month learn different aspects of running a sewing business taught by local business professionals & learn from local creative professionals their stories of startup & running of their businesses. FDIC notebook provided. Zoom format - 2nd & 4th Tuesday, 6-7:30 pm. Fee \$30 mon. or \$200/yr. (13mths.)
